





Our project is aimed at empowering schools to enhance and to assess equity through the development of several intellectual outputs and actions. We made progress on two intellectual outputs, the theoretical framework on equity and the description of best practices. 

The majority of the time in Swansea was spent progressing the theoretical framework of school equity. We had already defined school equity and we had also set six dimensions. It was time to go further and we split the six dimensions into several sub-dimensions, which will allow us to build an interactive rubric with four levels of attainment.


In the image below, you can see our definition of school equity, the six dimensions with a short description for each one and the sub-dimensions within each school equity dimension.



We have started to describe and to record best practice in school equity. We want to gather several best practices for each dimension of our school equity definition from the different participating countries. All practices will be available from our website. You can already watch two practices from our partner Institut El Calamot. One practice is “Educational Coaching” linked to our personal and social development dimension. The other one is “School Sports Plan” linked to our inclusion dimension.
